TRADE FAIR AND EXHIBITION 1954

THE Fair will be opened at 10.15 a.m. on Tuesday, 30th November, by Alderman D. W. Lansdown, J.P., a member of long standing and a former Chairman of the Faringdon and District Chamber of Trade.

This Chamber, first known as the Faringdon Traders' Association, was formed by a body of local tradesmen in December 1922. From that date until now no Trade Fair has been organised locally and it is hoped that the first effort will prove a success. The object is to provide, in a relatively small space, a comprehensive range of goods so that the townsfolk may see what local traders can offer, with particular emphasis on seasonable goods. Needless to say, the Organising Committee has arranged for Father Christmas to visit the Fair on Thursday, Friday and Saturday, December 2nd, 3rd and 4th, and we acknowledge with many thanks the assistance of our old friend, Mr. Percy Combe, in this matter.

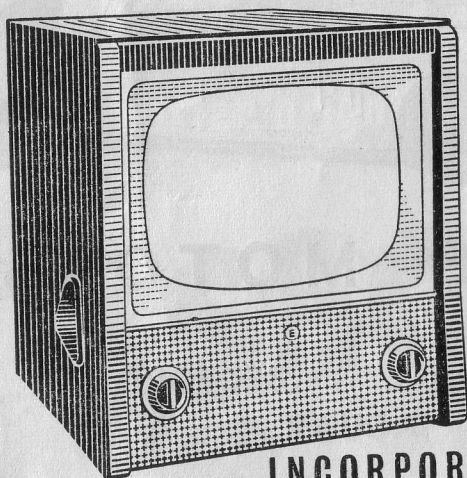

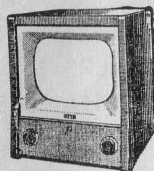
