



Flexicare is an Oxfordshire based charity providing a home sitting service for families with severely disabled children. Flexicare is fun, friendly, joyous, exhilarating, fulfilling (sometimes exhausting!) and always different. The team is comprised of a Manager (this post), Office Manager, three Co-ordinators and a cohort of volunteers. Hours of work are fully flexible, designed to fit around your existing commitments. The post of Flexicare Manager offers a truly satisfying role for the right individual. Running our charity is challenging, meeting the needs of families in difficult circumstances, and maintaining a service that is truly flexible, is not easy. The rewards, however, are significant. If you have a passion for children with disabilities, and their families, if you've ever wanted a job where every day you can see the real difference you are making, this is the role for you.

The charity has always been run from the home of the manager, and ideally this will continue. However, do not let this be a bar to chatting to us, if you believe you are the right person to take on this role.

- Management of all aspects of the governance of the charity, including liaison with Oxfordshire County Council,

- Is confident and forward thinking
- has experience of working with disabled children, in a health, social care, or educational role
- is experienced and capable in managing people and relationships
- is prepared to work flexibly (including some evenings and weekends)
- has use of a car for work purposes
